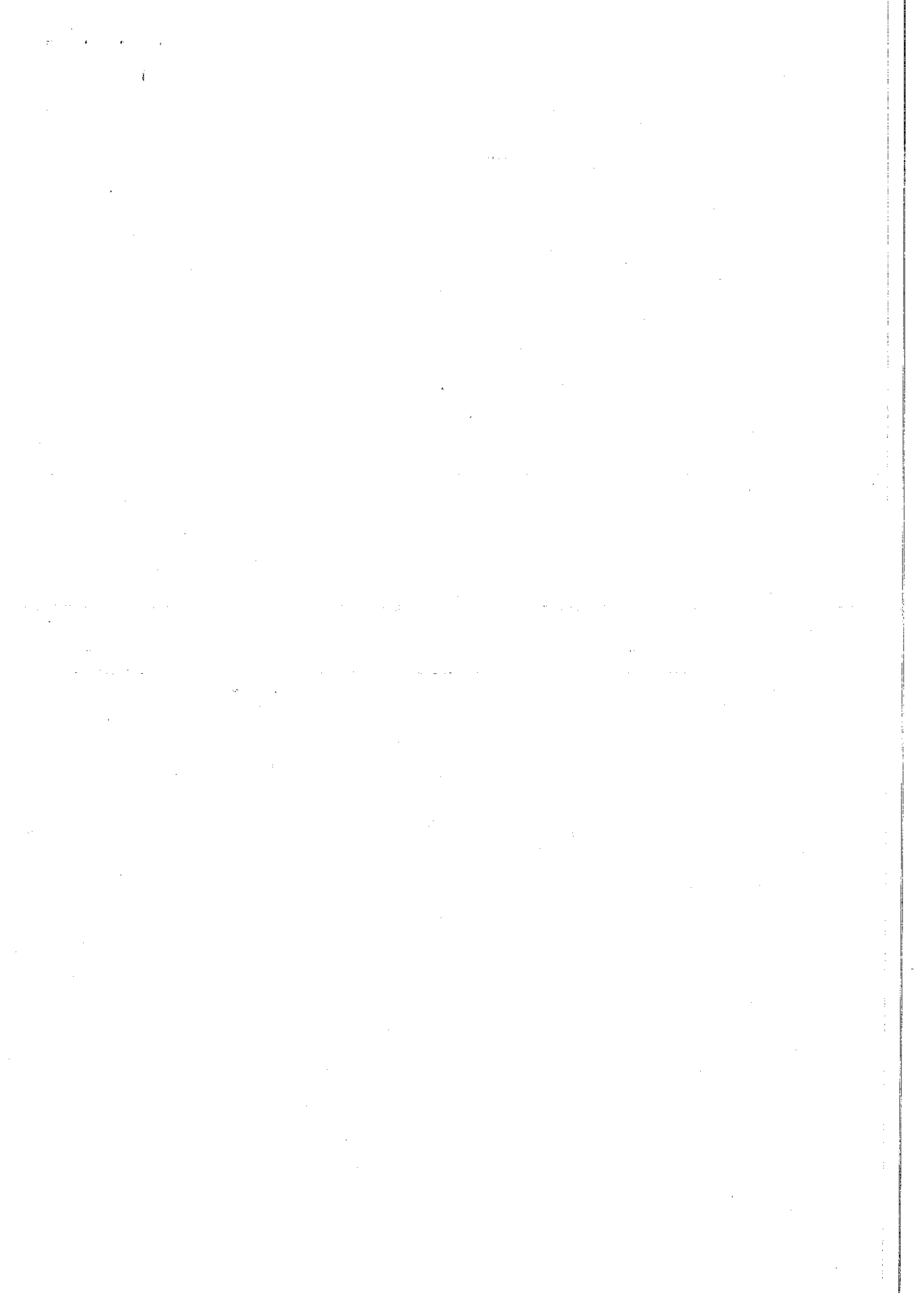



Guidelines for the scheme of "D. Devaraja Urs Videshi Vyasanga Vethana" for  
Backward Classes Candidates of Karnataka State.

I. THE SCHEME:

The scheme provides financial assistance to the eligible Backward Class candidates for pursuing Masters level courses and Ph.D/Research at abroad in the following specified field of study.

- a. Engineering & Technology.
- b. Management & Commerce.
- c. Sciences & Technology.
- d. Agriculture & Allied Sciences/Technology.
- e. Medicine.
- f. Humanities & Social Sciences.
- g. Any other.

II. ELIGIBILITY:

1. Educational Qualification:

- a. For Ph.D/Research: Minimum 60% marks or equivalent grade in relevant Master's Degree.
- b. For Master's Degree: Minimum 60% marks or equivalent grade in relevant Bachelor's Degree.

2. Age Limit:

Below 35 years, as on the last date fixed for submission of application for financial assistance. Date of birth as per SSLC marks card.

3. Income Ceiling:

Total income from all sources of the candidate and his/her parents/guardians should not exceed Rs.6.00 lakhs per annum.

4. The Candidate shall be a citizen of India and permanent resident of Karnataka State.

5. One Child in a Family and One Time Assistance:

Not more than one child of the same parents/guardians will be eligible and to this effect a self-certification will be required from the candidate. An individual can be given the financial assistance only once and cannot be considered for a second or subsequent time.

6. The candidates who are working under Central/State Government/Govt Aided Institutions/Public Undertakings are not eligible for financial assistance under this scheme.

### III. FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE:

Maximum Rs.10.00 Lakhs or actual expenditure whichever is lesser will be sanctioned annually. This includes Course fee, Living Expenses, Contingency, Air fare etc.,

### IV. DURATION OF FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE:

1. Ph.D/Research-Maximum 3 years or completion of the course whichever is earlier.
2. Masters Degree- Maximum 2 years or completion of the course whichever is earlier.

### V. MODE OF PAYMENT:

1. The candidate shall submit copies of current Passport and VISA and confirmation letter of admission in foreign University/Institution to get 1st year's financial assistance.
2. 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> year's financial assistance will be sanctioned only after the submission of progress report of the candidate through concerned University/Institutions.
3. Yearly financial assistance will be sanctioned to the candidates in a single installment in beginning of the academic year.
4. If the final year of the course (within the duration of financial assistance) is less than 6 months, the candidate will be sanctioned 50% of the annual financial assistance.
5. The payment will be made through NEFT/RTGS to the Bank account of the candidate.

### VI. SELECTION COMMITTEE:

The committee comprising of the following members will select the candidates & the decision of the selection committee shall be final.

## VII. SELECTION PROCEDURE:

1. The candidate shall submit on-line application in the prescribed format with required documents to the Commissioner, Backward Classes Welfare Department, Bengaluru.
2. Verification of the original documents will be done at the office of concerned District Backward Classes Welfare Officer.
3. Personal interview of the candidate will be conducted by the selection committee at Bengaluru.
4. The candidates will be selected on the basis of merit cum means & assessment of selection committee.
5. Categorywise Reservation is as follows.

6. If there are no eligible candidates in any of the category, the seats will be distributed among other categories as per reservation.
7. Under Category-1 50% seats will be reserved for the candidates of Nomadic/Semi Nomadic Tribes. If there are no eligible NT/SNT candidates seats will be filled up by other candidates of Category-1.
8. In each Category 33% will be reserved for women candidates, 5% for rural candidates & 3% for physically challenged candidates.
9. If there are no eligible Women candidates in a particular category seats will be filled up by the male candidates of the same category.
10. If there are no eligible Rural/Physically challenged candidates seats will be filled up by the other candidates of the same category.

## VIII. OTHER MANDATORY CONDITIONS:

1. The candidates are required to make their own efforts in seeking admission in accredited foreign University/Institutions to the courses specified in the scheme.
2. It will be for the candidate to obtain the appropriate Visa for a country wherein he/she intends to study further under the scheme.
3. The selected candidates shall obtain admission and join foreign University/Institution -

- On or before the last date fixed by the foreign University/Institution.
  - Within the financial year of selection i.e., from April to March.
  - In case the University/Institution extends the joining date beyond the financial year of selection, candidates are allowed to join.
  - On expiry of this specified period of time, selection for financial assistance will automatically get cancelled. No request for extension of time is permissible under the scheme.
4. The selected candidates may pursue their respective studies in an accredited University/Institution in country of their choice with which India has diplomatic relations, subject to prior approval of the Government of India/Government of Karnataka whose decision will be final and not challengeable.
  5. The selected candidates shall execute a bond in prescribed format for abiding the conditions of the scheme.
  6. A surety (either land holder or Government employee) for each selected candidate shall execute surety bond separately for the actual amount to be sanctioned by the Backward Classes Welfare Department, Bengaluru.
  7. The candidates shall not change the course of study or research for which financial assistance has been sanctioned.
  8. In case the candidate has received over payment from Backward Classes Welfare Department, he/she shall refund the same to Government of Karnataka.
  9. Yearly progress report of the candidates from concerned University/Institution is required to sanction financial assistance for renewals.
  10. Only in following special cases the Backward Classes Welfare Department is authorised to allow the candidate to change the University/Institutions after making such correspondence and satisfied about such a need for change.
    - If the candidate finds himself/herself in a serious situation where his/her Guide has left and there are no immediate replacements thereof.
    - If the University/Institution has discontinued the research support facilities in the area where the candidate was pursuing Ph.D/Research.
    - But the total period of financial assistance will remain unchanged even on transfer/change can be considered only in rare cases.



11. After completion of higher studies the candidate shall submit course completion certificate issued by the concerned University/Institution to the Commissioner, Backward Classes Welfare Department, Bengaluru.
12. The candidate shall inform the Commissioner, Backward Classes Welfare Department, Bengaluru, regarding placement after completion of studies.

IX. DEFAULT UNDER THE SCHEME:-


1. In following situations, the candidate shall be declared as a defaulter and shall be liable to refund the entire amount paid to him/her along with interest at 15% per annum or such rate as may be fixed from time to time by Government of Karnataka.
  - If he/she violates any of the terms and conditions of the bonds executed by him/her.
  - If the educational University/Institution intimates the Indian Mission/Embassy abroad/Government of Karnataka about his/her adverse reports on studies and/or conduct.
  - If the candidates join any other University or Course/Programme during the period of financial assistance.
  - If the candidate absconds/discontinues the study.
  - If the candidate does not submit yearly academic progress report.
2. In case the defaulter fails to repay the amount within six months from the date on which a demand for such refund is made, penal interest at the rate which is 2.5% higher than the aforesaid rate of interest on the outstanding amount would be charged.
3. If the defaulter fails to repay such amount along with the interest there on in the manner decided by the Government of Karnataka, his/her surety who has executed bond, shall be liable to pay the entire amount, failing which the Deputy Commissioner of the concerned district shall realize the amount as arrears of land revenue.

X. FURNISHING OF FALSE INFORMATION:-

If any candidate furnished any false information/document and if established as false, he/she shall be debarred from the financial assistance and if he/she has availed of it or is availing, an action will be initiated for recovery of the amount paid with 15% compound interest thereon. Criminal procedure will be initiated against such candidates as per law.

XI. LITIGATION:-

Any litigation on matters arising out of this scheme in India will be subject to sole jurisdiction of the courts situated in Bengaluru. The litigations arising abroad will be dealt appropriately by the Government.
